Graduate Program

The Graduate program also includes leadership training via the MacKellar Leadership Academy.

Apprenticeship Program

MacKellar Group's Apprenticeship program is aimed at new-to-industry applicants and is extremely competitive.

Recruitment takes place once a year for MacKellar's Apprenticeships which commence in January of the following year. You can stay up to date with our application open dates by following our website and social media.

Successful applicants work full time and get paid while learning in a four-year competency based program, which combines workplacebased training combined with formal learning through Hastings Deering Registered Training Organisation (RTO).
